### **Summary of interview**

01 – First job as a dentist in Grimsby. Setting up practice in Lincoln (interruption – door bell)

02 – Setting up practice continued. Types of operation carried out.

03 – Use of general anaesthesia, training in general anaesthesia, anaesthetic techniques used including description of the Jorgensen technique. Description of drugs used. Mention of the Association of Dental Anaesthetists. Discussion on the use of Brietal. Discussion of complications.

04 – Drummond Jackson and the Society for the Advancement of Anaesthesia in Dentistry. Use of Brietal.

05 – Discussion on Seward report on sedation and general anaesthesia in dentistry. Discussion of the Poswillo report on general anaesthesia and sedation (interruption – door bell).

06 – Continued discussion on the Poswillo report. Role of consultant anaesthetists. General Dental Council involvement in general anaesthesia. Poggo clinics.

07 – Discussion of Poggo clinics and Professor David Poswillo's support of them.

08 – Involvement in the fluoridation of water in Lincolnshire.

09 - Role as dental advisor to Lincolnshire Health Authority (interruption – coughing).

10 – Continued discussion of role as dental advisor to Lincolnshire Health Authority.

11 - Continued discussion of role as dental advisor to Lincolnshire Health Authority. Training of dental nurses in Lincolnshire.

12 – Discussion of work with Geoff Hutchinson, the first consultant in oral surgery in Lincoln.
