Key speakers include **Peter Briggs** (*Consultant in Restorative Dentistry, Queen Mary University of London and Specialist Practitioner*)

Peter was appointed as a consultant in 1995; he also started a specialist referral practice in the same year. He qualified at King's College Hospital in 1983 and worked in full time NHS dental practice before returning to secondary care to do a MSc Cons at the Eastman in 1997-98. This was followed by various registrar jobs at Eastman, King's, Royal London and St. George's. Peter was a Clinical Director for 15 years during which time one of his key focuses was the development of secondary care clinical services in South West London (SWL) and the training of dentists with Enhanced Skills.
