1. Minutes of last AGM and matters arising there from

Minutes were accepted as true record and signed by Chair, Bill Abbot. There were no matters arising

2. Correspondence and questions

No correspondence has been received for AGM to consider.

3. Council Report

Bill Abbot advised that BDA Essex Branch had had another successful year and thanked everyone for his or her continued work, support and commitment. In particular, he mentioned the work of Mansoor Qureshi, Bob Davey and Monica Reinach.

He advised that BDA Essex Branch had regular meetings in Chelmsford and that everyone was welcome. He emphasized that the more active Branch was, the more influence it is likely to have. He cited a report in the press on the previous day which highlighted the increasing numbers of children requiring general anaesthesia for extractions and wondered what the effect of the 2006 and the exit of dentists from NHS services had on this.

4. Financial Statement

Mansoor Qureshi presented the financial statement to the AGM, indicating that the Branch had a surplus of £3148.70. A grant was received on submission of the accounts of £7000 and the current account as of the previous day stood at



£20,000. There was a proposal to accept the report by Mr E Fox which was seconded by Mr C Bainbridge.

5. Valedictory Address of Retiring President

Mr R Davey explained how he had been privileged to act as the President for the previous year. He felt that the profession who had previously worked in silos was now acting as a great group. He felt there was strength in the region through an active and supportive LDC with a gathering group of CPD days and preventative workforce developments through bodies such as the University of Essex.

He thanked Monica Reinach as BDA Benevolent fund rep for her work with a successful Summer Ball which raised £9000 for the fund and encouraged everyone to attend the Winter Ball this coming Christmas.

6. Inaugural Address of President

Mr W Tweddell felt that we needed to encourage more dentists to work together as a group, especially the young dentists. He was hoping to arrange a cultural study tour to San Sebastian, especially as it had the highest number of Michelin Star restaurants of anywhere.

7. Election of Officers for the Ensuing Year

The present committee confirmed that they were all prepared to remain in their current positions for another year and Mr R Davey proposed the motion that all current officers were to remain in position. The motion was seconded by Piers Lambert and passed unanimously.

Dr M Reinach also thanked everyone for their support of the Benevolent Fund and indicated that the recent amount was the largest gathered in the UK with the next Ball planned for be close to Christmas

A vote of thanks from Bryan Harvey was given to the current committee for their work this year.
