**AMENDMENTS TO THE STATEMENT OF DENTAL REMUNERATION  
(SDR)**

**Fees Increase**

Please find enclosed an updated SDR, which reflects a 4.5% increase to gross fees and allowances payable from the 1 April 2022.

The effective date for implementation of the SDR will be backdated to the 1 April 2022.

**The new fees will be automatically applied from the following dates: -**

HS45 paper claims submitted after 19<sup>th</sup> May 2023  
EDI Transmissions submitted after 12<sup>th</sup> June 2023

**Changes to Determination I (Scale of Fees)**

Gross figures have been updated by 4.5%. The new fees and associated patient charges should be applied to all courses of treatment starting on or after 1 April 2022. However, patient charges which have already been paid by patients and recouped from dentists based on the old fee scale should not be recalculated.

**Changes to Determination II (Rates of Remuneration for Salaried Service and the provision of Emergency Dental Service)**

Salaried figures have been updated to match stated pay rise in extant pay circular [HSC \(TC8\)03/2022](#).

### **Changes to Determination III (Seniority Payments)**

Gross figures have been updated by 4.5%.

### **Changes to Determination IV (DFT Allowances, GPT Allowances and Post Grad Allowances etc)**

Gross figures have been updated by 4.5%.

### **Changes to Determination V (Maternity, Paternity and Adoption Leave Payments)**

Gross figures have been updated by 4.5%.

### **Changes to Determination VI (Long-Term Sickness)**

Gross figures have been uplifted by 4.5%.

### **Changes to Determination VII (CPD Allowances)**

Gross figures and Allowances have been uplifted by 4.5%.

### **Changes to Determination VIII (Reimbursement of Non-domestic Rates)**

Gross figures have been uplifted by 4.5%.

### **Changes to Determination IX (Clinical Audit Allowances)**

Gross figures have been uplifted by 4.5%.

### **Changes to Determination X (Practice Allowances)**

Gross figures have been uplifted by 4.5%.
