Sleep Disordered Breathing

Dental sleep medicine is an area of dental practice that focuses on the use of oral appliance therapy to treat sleep-disordered breathing, including snoring and obstructive sleep apnoea (OSA). Dentists have a role in the use of custom-fit oral sleep appliances an effective treatment that prevents the airway from collapsing by supporting the jaw in a forward position.

Course Aims and Objectives

This course is designed to give participants

- An overview of sleep disordered breathing
- An explanation of how oral appliances work
- How to assess and monitor patients and select those for treatment in practice
- An overview of custom devices and laboratory requirements and procedures
- Demonstration of protrusive registration, device fitting and appliance evaluation

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
